

2020 Sugar Beet Harvest

Grower Contract Card and Tare Sample Card Handling Procedure

In order to eliminate/minimize handling of cards during beet harvest, all grower beet delivery truck personnel are required to present the grower contract card to the Lantic Scale Operator with a ~1m stick with two durable clips securely attached to the end of the stick.

The scale operator will scan the grower card with the laser gun. If a tare sample is required for the load, the scale operator will scan and attach a sanitized tare sample card on the second clip.

If you received a tare sample card, place the entire stick out of the cab window when staged for unloading at the piler. The tare person will remove the tare sample card from the clip and proceed to collect a tare sample from your load.

After you have unloaded and received your tare weight, the scale operator will attach your Final Weigh Ticket to the clip.

The goal of this procedure is to remain physically distanced from the piling ground staff and eliminate Covid-19 transmission from frequently touched surfaces.

Please practice good hand hygiene either by washing your hands or using a 60% alcohol based hand sanitizer.
